




### HELMET COLORING CONTEST

- BrainMinders<sup>TM</sup> is Pilot International's signature program originally designed in 2001 to teach safety to children to help prevent brain injuries.
- Pilots have expanded the program to include presentations for youth and seniors.
- Most Pilot Clubs as well as many Anchor and Compass Clubs present BrainMinder<sup>TM</sup> Programs to persons of all ages, based on the services needed in their community.
- In 2017, an appointed Pilot International BrainMinders<sup>TM</sup> Committee developed an enhanced website presence and a program with revised and new materials for presentations to preschoolers, children, youth, and seniors.
