### Growth in Membership

### Mentoring of Members

- Encourage new members to share their ideas and be willing to listen and consider how they can be used in the club - new ideas can energize the club

### Leadership Opportunities

- Make sure club members understand the job descriptions and what they will be responsible to do and help them find a job where they can use their talents
